School Day Timings – We are still following covid guidance in relation to schools. This will mean that at the end of the school day P1 & P2 children will go out slightly earlier at 3.10pm and P3-7 at 3.15pm. An email was sent out to families on Tuesday morning to confirm these timings. Please ensure you continue to follow social distancing guidelines whilst waiting to collect your child(ren).



PE Days – We are still configuring PE timetables, teachers will confirm PE days as soon as this has been decided. On PE days we will be encouraging children to come dressed in their PE kit but with their Pitmedden School jumper. Information around this will come out via Seesaw and not Google Classroom.

Seesaw – Reflecting on the feedback from parents/carers, it is clear that increased communication and sharing of pupil learning is a key focus at Pitmedden. With this in mind, we have purchased Seesaw and our staff engaged in some training around this during the in-service day. This is a fabulous tool to share pupil learning and increase home-school communication. There will be information coming out very soon to help parents/family members connect to your child's Seesaw. This will replace the use of Google Classroom. We hope you will enjoy seeing a clearer picture of your children's learning. Please do not hesitate in contacting the school if you have any questions around Seesaw or require support.

As always, these dates can be subject to change but as much as possible we would anticipate that these dates would not be moved unless essential.
